State Officer Screening

Applications to be a 2022-2023 State Officer must be submitted by January 19th, 2022. Screening will take place on January 29th, at Brownsburg High School.

Officer screening will consist of a written exam and two interviews. In order to be considered as an officer candidate, you must score at least 70% on the written exam and have a combined exam and interview score of 70% along with recommendation from the screening committee. The study guide for the exam and interview can be found on indianadeca.org website and will be used to select qualified candidates for the opportunity to run. It is an honor and very rewarding to hold an officer position. We hope to see you there and best of luck!
