## State Officer Screening

Applications must be submitted by Wednesday, January 13, 2021. State officer screening will take place on January 23, 2021. Officer screening will consist of a written test and two interviews. In order to be considered as an officer candidate vou must score at least 70% on the written test. Combined scores on the exam and interviews along with other material submitted with the application will be used to select qualified candidates. Candidates should receive a combined minimum average score of 70% to be recommended by the committee.
